Julia explained that there are still tasks outstanding that have not been sent to Suzanne.

- An audit should have been done to identify what is in place and any problems arising. Please send these to Julia ASAP.
- Vision for training tool. We need to create a list of contents. For the last project there was a lot of work before knowing what we wanted to achieve. Julia showed a contents page template and everybody was given a form to fill in suggestions. Katrina stated that this had been done previously in Romania.
- Each chapter of the project should have an assessment; Julio explained that we have to have an ambassador from each school at the end of the assessments. Janice suggested 3 ambassadors, 1 for each category.
- Julio explained that the aim is to make an app for everybody involved in the project. He then showed us an example of an app. He suggested photo, password then a self-evaluation table. The app should be very visual with pictures and symbols. Ainars suggested that it may be easier to use google forms. Victor suggested it would be better on a PC rather than an app.
- We realised we still have no idea what an ambassador is which is one of the most important things for us to decide.
- Katrina discussed the several dimensions to health and suggested we perhaps choose 1 per country and then each country can circulate the results. Reet was unsure of how this would work in her school and suggested a draft is brought to the first Year 2 visit.
- The final decision made was that we would have 1 ambassador for each country on one area. We should go away and come up with a list of ideas and put it all together in Latvia. Then any changes can be made so there is a definite list by the Ireland visit.
